— run a pre-operational testing phase to verify the functionalities of the system.

The purpose of the procurement is to improve GNSS interference detection capabilities of spectrum management authorities, which are currently limited (either geographically and in reporting capabilities).

In addition, the contractor shall develop a GNSS interference reporting procedure to public authorities and update the GSA radiofrequency threats database. This stage shall last 3 months;

(b) the second stage of the contract targets the design, development, pre-operational testing and the handover of the system. This stage shall last 45 months.
