



CLARIFICATION NOTE 2

Question no.1: What is the use that the GSA and the European Union can make of the results of the action, and in particular of the demonstration kit?

Answer: By way of signing the grant agreement, the beneficiary(-ies) shall grant the GSA and the European Commission the right to use all the results of the action (whereby "results" has the meaning foreseen under Article II.1 of the draft multi-beneficiaries and mono-beneficiary grant agreements), including the demonstration kit, for institutional purposes only.

"Institutional purpose" is any non-commercial purpose related to the development, operation, maintenance and service provision of the European Union Space Programmes (definition under Article II.1 of the draft multi-beneficiaries and mono-beneficiary grant agreements).

A non-exhaustive list of uses of the results allowed for such institutional purposes is specified under Article I.9.4 of the draft multi-beneficiaries and mono-beneficiary grant agreements.

Question no.2: Are both the source code and the object code mandatory deliverables for this Call for Proposals?

Answer: Neither the source code nor the object code are deliverables requested under section 2.4 of the Call for Proposals. Nonetheless, the GSA and the European Commission shall have the right to use the object code (as per the reply to Question 1) for institutional purposes as it is necessarily part of the deliverable (8) requested under section 2.4 of the Call for Proposals.
