Question no.1: In the text of the call you write the following

Maximum budget allocated for EU financing under this action: **EUR 1,500,000.00**

Indicative number of projects: up to 2 projects

Maximum EU co-financing rate of eligible costs:**70%**

If deemed valuable do you intent to finance 1,5 M€ for each of the selected project ?

Or is it the maximum combined sum of the financing of the two projects that must not exceed 1,5 M€ ?

Answer: The budget of EUR 1,500,000.00 is the maximum combined sum of the financing of the two projects.

Question no.2: We are considering applying to the call GSA/GRANT/07/201 on development of a drone-borne double frequency Galileo receiver. We are looking to implement Galileo HAS support but the status of the service is not clear to me. Obviously the message structure and details is important for us to evaluate the effort required and submit a proposal.

Can you tell me if an ICD already exists for the corrections messages and can you share some details? What is the expected date for initial broadcasting of a test signal on the satellites?

Answer: Please note that, as per the decision of the Commission, the HAS will be implemented in the E6 band. As explained in Corrigendum No. 2, the GSA will provide access to the ICD to applicants upon signature of a non-disclosure undertaking. Please note that such ICD is subject to evolutions, and that we cannot provide any information on initial date of broadcasting.

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
