

CLARIFICATION NOTE 7

NOTA BENE: Applicants are reminded that questions concerning this Call for Proposals shall be addressed to the GSA's functional mailbox gns-grants@gsa.europa.eu and the subject of the email shall read "GSA/GRANT/07/2019 Development of a drone-borne double frequency Galileo receiver". Processing of emails which do not bear this subject line may be delayed.

Question no.1: Is it allowed to engage in our Consortium for this Call a Drone Operator, as subcontractor explicitly mentioned in the proposal, with the task of operating the trials\demos of the developed receiver, being this Drone Operator also part, as Partner, of another Consortium applying to the same call?

Answer: Participation of the same legal entity in multiple calls for proposals (regardless of its quality as prime, consortium member or subcontractor) is not precluded by default.

However, such a participation shall not lead to any collusion or exchange of information which would influence the content of each of the proposals. Therefore, the consortia in question must provide clear evidence of the measures which were taken to ensure that the different proposals in which the same legal entity participates are independent, specifically that the participation of the same legal entity in multiple calls for proposals did not influence the content of each of those proposals.

In case the consortium does not demonstrate the above-mentioned measures, the concerned proposals will be excluded from the grant procedure in their entirety.

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
