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# Enablers of EUSPA

## What is it?

- Support services, includes administrative support, market support, engineering support, management support, communications support, SADEP support, legal support
- If the choice of the model of the Agency can be summarised as ‘make’ or ‘buy’, the choice of the co-decision makers (Council + Parliament) for this financial perspective to end 2027 is ‘buy’
- The Agency procures such support services either through its own procurement processes or participating in the procurement processes of other EU entities (‘inter-institutional procurements’)
- Normally committed through series of Specific Contracts under Framework Contracts lasting for total duration of up to 4 years

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## What is it?

- Provision of services provided at EUSPA facilities (in particular today Prague, St Germain en Laye, Toulouse, Madrid, Noordwijk) and from contractors' premises
- Increasing focus on provision of 'deliverables' as opposed to 'services'
- Depending on the support service in question, requiring ability to handle EU Classified Information, including up to level of Secret-UE/EU-Secret

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## Where will it be in 5 years?

- For the rest of this financial perspective to end 2027 the activities of EUSPA, and therefore the expected support services needed, are decided, as set out for each of the components presented
- For the next financial perspective from 2028, the EUSPA need for support services will be driven by:
  - The future of each of the components, and possible new components and activities
  - The future role of the Agency in each of the components, and possible new components and activities
  - The future model of the Agency, and whether there is any change to the 'make' or 'buy' model together with changes and potential additions to the Agency's sites
- We take note of the Commission's proposal for the European Competitiveness Fund (ECF) and the EU Space Act, we look forward to proposal for the Agency Regulation

  - Corporate Quality Support:
    - Support to Corporate Quality and Programmes' Oversight Function: FWC for €4M signed in Feb 2024

  - Legal support:
    - Lot 1: Legal advice and support related to the EU Space Programme: FWC for €4M, signed Aug 2022
    - Lot 2: Legal advice and support related to Security: FWC for €2M, signed Aug 2022
    - Lot 3: Legal advice and support related to Administration: FWC for €2M, signed Aug 2022
- Many, many other contracts including for:
  - Management Consultancy Services, Learning & Development Services, Medical Services, Health & Safety Support Services, Facilities Services, Cleaning Services, Guarding Services, Catering Services, Reception Services, Insurance, Telephony, Audit, EMAS Certification etc etc

- FWC for €410k for Provision of Stationery, Office Supplies, and Office Related Consumables for EUSPA Premises in the Czech Republic and Spain, planned

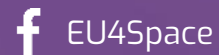
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
