



Call for Expression of Interest to join EUSPA's EU
Space Pavilion at ENLIT Europe 2026 (10-12 November
2026 | Vienna, Austria)

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1 Introduction

The European Union Agency for the Space Programme (EUSPA) is hereby inviting companies developing innovative space-enabled solutions within the energy sector to express their interest in participating at the Enlit Europe 2026 event attending the EU Space for Energy Pavilion.

The event will be taking place in Vienna, Austria, from 10 to 12 November 2026.

The EU Space for Energy Pavilion is created to showcase how European space capabilities support the energy transition through innovative commercial solutions based on satellite navigation, Earth Observation, satellite communications and other space-enabled services.

EUSPA intends to support interested companies which meet the eligibility requirements set out in this call for expression of interest (the "Call") by providing access to and the possibility of benefiting from exhibition space and pavilion infrastructure **provided by EUSPA to Participants at no cost**, subject to the conditions of the Call and the available capacity of the pavilion.

The legal basis for this initiative is article 244 of Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2024/2509.

This initiative aims at bringing together companies demonstrating the value of EU Space technologies for energy applications and at facilitating engagement with utilities, network operators, energy companies, public authorities, investors, and other stakeholders from across the European energy ecosystem.

2 Purpose of the Call

2.1 Who should apply?

We are looking for companies that offer products, services or solutions relevant to the energy sector and leveraging one or more space-based components, including:

- Satellite navigation and positioning (Galileo, EGNOS)
- Earth observation and geospatial analytics
- Satellite communications and connectivity
- Critical infrastructure monitoring
- Grid management and resilience
- Renewable energy planning and operations
- Asset monitoring and predictive maintenance
- Climate and environmental intelligence
- Emergency response and resilience applications
- Digital twins and data-driven energy services

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Both SMEs¹ and larger companies are welcome to apply.

2.2 What EUSPA will provide

Selected companies will receive, free of charge:

- Exhibition space within the **EU Space for Energy Pavilion** at Enlit Europe 2026.
- A dedicated company showcase area within the pavilion.
- Pavilion infrastructure, basic furniture and branding.
- Visibility through a common EU Space visual identity and communication campaign.
- Promotion through relevant EUSPA communication channels and event-related activities.
- Access to networking opportunities with energy-sector stakeholders attending the event.

Participation in the pavilion is offered at **no cost** to the selected companies.

Selected participants will be responsible for their own travel, accommodation and any additional expenses not specifically covered by EUSPA.

3 Assessment of Applications

3.1 Eligibility Criteria

Applications must:

- be submitted by legal entities established in the territory of the Member States of the European Union;
- propose a solution relevant to the energy sector;
- demonstrate the use of, or clear connection to, EU Space assets, data or services;
- commit to active participation during Enlit Europe 2026.

3.2 Award Criteria

The evaluation will be conducted based on the order of receipt of the applications email, on the basis of the date and time of such receipt.

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The first eighteen (18) eligible applications submitted will be invited to participate at the EU Space Pavilion at Enlit Europe 2026.

4 Submission of Expression of Interest

Interested companies are invited to submit a request to the Agency via email to tenders@euspa.europa.eu including:

- a) Filled and signed Legal Entity Form and the attachments requested in (available here: [Business partners – legal entities and bank accounts - European Commission](#));
- b) A description of no more than two (2) pages of the following:
 - Company name and contact details;
 - Short company description;
 - Description of the proposed solution, product or service to be showcased;
 - Explanation of its relevance to the energy sector, including target users, customers and/or use cases;
 - Description of the EU Space assets, data or services used (e.g. Galileo, EGNOS, Copernicus, SATCOM, IRIS²-related services, etc.);
 - Indication of any planned demonstration, use case presentation, customer story or showcase that could be featured as part of the pavilion programme;
 - Short motivation statement covering:
 - why the company wishes to participate in Enlit Europe 2026;
 - how it expects to contribute to the EU Space Pavilion;
 - what outcomes it hopes to achieve from participation;
 - how its solution supports the energy transition or addresses challenges faced by the energy sector

The deadline for submissions of expression of interest is 30th September 2026 (23:59, Prague local time, CZ).

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
