Are you producing a video for EUSPA? Please follow these steps.

1. Share your script

Please send your project plan, story board and your video script to EUSPA Communications mailbox:

2. Use this guideline

Follow this guideline and download the motion graphics needed for your project.

Consult us in case you have any questions.

3. Share a draft

As you progress with your work, feel free to share drafts of your project with EUSPA Communications to receive feedback or to get answers to any of your questions.

4. Final approval

Share the final version of your video with us and receive a final approval from EUSPA.

Without the final approval, the video cannot be published or shared with other parties.



Tone

EUSPA produces a variety of videos, from formal and informative content to casual and friendly, or to documentary-like videos. Formal and informative videos focus on general information about EUSPA or the EU Space Programme and its components; casual and friendly tone would include event videos, publications release, year wraps, entrepreneurship or HR related content, cartoons or animations; and finally, documentary-like videos, which usually cover specific topics focused on the different segments in which EU Space data and services are used.

Editing style

Formal and informative

Corporative and less intrusive music

Length: 1-3 minutes

Usually no transition effects, nor intros are used

Casual and friendly

Upbeat / positive energy music

Length: 1-3 minutes or ideally less

Free use of transitions and related effects / text effects

Event-related intro, topic-related intro often used

Documentary

Various music clips that accompany or underscore the mood of the particular part of the documentary

Length: 3-8 minutes

Usually no transition effects

Slower/shorter documentary intro




Watermark

EUSPA videos are watermarked with EUSPA logo (acronym version) placed in the top left corner and the #EUSpace mark in the top right corner (see example on the right).

For 1080p and 4k videos, there are available filters to simply drag and drop onto a project in a video editing software. You can download them here: 1080p, 4k.

In case of a different set up of the ratio, the logos can be downloaded separately at: https://www.euspa.europa.eu/about/euspa-identity. Here it's also possible to download variations of CASSINI logo, to be used when doing videos involving that project.





Lower thirds (speaker's info)

There are two versions of EUSPA's lower thirds. Dark and light. Feel free to choose the colour of your preference.

White – blue letters (light version) is available here.

Blue – white letters (dark version) is available here.

Name is in Exo-Bold font and Title and Company are in Nunito Sans-SemiBold font.





Text on screen

For text on screen, you can use our "bubbles" which are also available in dark and light versions.

White – blue letters (light version) is available <u>here (right side)</u> and <u>here (left side)</u>.

Blue – white letters (dark version) is available here (right side) and here (left side).

EUSPA uses EXO and Nunito Sans fonts in its different variations, especially Regular and SemiBold. Feel free to use the one that suits your video.
