

Privacy statement on the protection of personal data in relation to the access to the restricted website page containing Administrative Board and Management personal data

All personal data are dealt with in compliance with the applicable rules on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data (currently Regulation (EU) No 2018/1725).

The following data protection information notice outlines the criteria by which the EUSPA collects, manages and uses the data in relation to the access request and granting of access to restricted website content containing Administrative Board and Management personal data.

Identity of controller and data protection officer:

Purpose(s) of processing:

The purpose of the processing is to grant access to a restricted section of the EUSPA website containing personal data of Administrative Board member and EUSPA Management, while enhancing the protection of such personal data against impersonation attempts and misuse, in parallel to fulfilling EUSPA transparency obligations.

Data/Categories of data concerned:

- Name
- Email address
- Organisation (if applicable)

Recipients/Categories of recipients of the data processed:

- EUSPA Communications Department
- Website administrator/contractor

The data subject is obliged to provide the personal data based on the necessity to submit the required information in order to obtain access to the restricted webpage. If the data subject does not provide the personal data, access to the restricted content will not be granted.

Legal basis/Lawfulness of the processing:

Processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest / in the exercise of official authority vested in EUSPA (Art. 5(1)(a) of Regulation 2018/1725).

The processing contributes to ensuring transparency of EUSPA activities while safeguarding personal data from misuse such as impersonation attempts.

Information on the storage locations and retention period of personal data:

The retention period of personal data is 12 months.

Once the retention period is over, personal data are deleted.

The personal data will be stored on EUSPA website infrastructure and related IT systems located in the European Union.

Transferring the data to third countries:

Data subjects have the right:

- To obtain confirmation as to whether or not his or her personal data are being processed, access the data and obtain detailed information on the processing;
- Of rectification of inaccurate personal data;
- Of erasure of personal data if the statutory provisions are met;
- Of restriction of processing if the statutory provisions are met;
- To object to processing;
- To lodge a complaint to the European Data Protection Supervisor at EDPS@edps.europa.eu should they consider that the processing operations do not comply with Regulation (EU) No 2018/1725.
