applicable and deemed necessary, the GSA will provide available reports of related studies that the contractor might need in order to conduct the activities envisaged within the present framework contract. When assigning the specific contracts (SC) under the framework contract, the GSA will proceed by reopening the competition among the contractors and will define more detailed requirements in the SC Tender Specifications.
