

### CLARIFICATION NO.7

Related to tender No. GSA/OP/04/11 - Engineering Services  
for GSA

Question: As per the Structure of the Tender indications, section 2.3 of the Tender Specification at page 10 is it correct to assume that Sections 1 to 4 can go in the Technical envelope and Section 5 in the Financial? Moreover if the above is correct can Sections 1 to 4 be part of one folder/binder?

Answer: No! Tenders MUST be submitted in sealed envelopes as described in the Invitation to Tender. The order of documents submitted in the inner sealed envelope should follow the order described under section 2.3 of the Tender Specifications. Each section has to be clearly and separately identifiable. Sections should not be summarized under the header of another section, e.g. by including them under an envelope labeled "Technical Proposal". When submitting different sections in one binder, each section should be clearly identifiable, e.g. by including separating pages labeled according to the section concerned. In case the contracting authority is unable to clearly identify the different sections from the documents submitted, the tender may be considered incomplete and subject to rejection. the tender may be considered incomplete and subject to rejection.
