In case subcontractors' economic and financial capacity is not relevant to the purpose of demonstrating compliance to the economic and financial capacity requirements, subcontractors are not requested to provide such evidence.

If, for some exceptional reason which GSA considers justified, a tenderer is unable to provide one or other of the above documents, the tenderer may prove its economic and financial capacity by any



other document which GSA considers appropriate. In any case, GSA must at least be notified of the exceptional reason and its justification in the tender. GSA reserves the right to request any other document enabling it to verify the tenderer's economic and financial capacity.

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
