MyGalileoDrone Prize Contest

Question #88: Regarding the Gantt Chart, is there any requirement on the level of detail it should contain and on the format of it (e.g. pdf, MS Office etc.)?

Answer #88: The Gantt chart should describe the activities to be performed in order to develop the application, integrate Galileo and test it. The level of detail and format is on applicant's discretion.

Question #89: Considering the Q.72 of the Clarification Note 3 (ref.: 259207), in case the service/application is already developed and completed, do applicants still need to address the future activities in the Gantt chart?

Answer #89: Yes, in case the development will be completed by the end of the competition, the applicants should describe the activities planned also after the end of the competition in order to commercialise the application / service.

Question #90: Can the GSA provide more information on how the applicants can implement an ambitious application in a one-man team?

Answer #90: The applicant should envisage how to develop a demo version of the application required in Phase 2 in Finals. During the first phase GSA evaluates applications and will shortlist 30 contestants for the phase two. During the next phases GSA will provide technical, safety and business mentoring to support the development (see clarification note #1, ref.:259061). Applicants may join the discussion on Slack channel of the competition to identify additional partners or teammates that could join the project. The GSA cannot assess applications and provide further assistance to the applicants at the applications' submission step.

Question #91: If there is only registration number for the entity, can it be used both as registration and VAT number for the purposes of filling-in the legal entity form?

Answer #91: If the registration number is the same with the VAT number, the applicants should fill the same number in both the relevant sections of the legal entity form. If the company does not have a VAT number, it should add a note explaining the reasons for it.

Question #92: Can large enterprises participate in the competition or the competition is only open to small businesses?

Answer #92: Participation in the contest is open to legal entities without any restriction with regard to their size (section 'Eligibility Criteria' of the Terms of Reference).



Question #93: Regarding the format of the application form, should teams utilize the fonts/margins and overall format of the original application form template? Should teams also keep-in the box "FILL-IN INSTRUCTIONS" in the first page and/or the informative texts in the different sections?

Answer #93: The format of the application form (i.e. template) shall be kept by the applicant. The instruction boxes throughout the document and the font/margins of such document is on applicants' discretion to retain.

Question #94: Can new team members be added to a team during the second phase of the contest?

Answer #94: Yes, new team members can be added to a team during the different phases of the contest, subject to the fulfillment of the exclusion and selection criteria, as set in the Terms of Reference of the contest, evidenced by the Declaration of Honour and the Legal Entity Form documents.
