We use cookies to personalise content, provide social media features, and analyse our website traffic. Cookies are small text files stored on your device to ensure the smooth operation of our website and enhance your experience. While some cookies are essential for the basic functioning of the site, others help us tailor your experience and require your consent.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of data stored on your device when you visit websites. These can be first-party cookies, placed directly by our website, or third-party cookies, set by external services that appear on our site. Cookies serve various purposes, such as remembering your preferences or tracking your interaction with our website to help us improve its functionality.

Types of cookies we use:

- Necessary cookies:** These cookies are crucial for the basic operation of our website. They enable core functionalities like navigation and access to secure areas, without which the website cannot function correctly. These cookies are automatically placed when you visit the website and do not require your explicit consent.
- Statistics cookies:** These cookies help us gather anonymous data about how visitors use our website. By analysing this information, we can optimise the performance of our website and improve your browsing experience. We use these cookies to monitor traffic patterns, page usage, and other metrics. These cookies are only placed if you provide your consent.
- Social media cookies:** These cookies facilitate integration with social media platforms like Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, and YouTube. They allow you to share content from our website and interact with our social media channels directly from our site. These cookies are only placed if you provide consent.

How we use cookies:

We use cookies for a variety of purposes:

- **Essential and functional cookies:** These ensure that our website operates efficiently, providing basic features such as keeping you logged in, enabling navigation between pages, and ensuring secure access to protected areas. These cookies are automatically placed when you visit the website and do not require your explicit consent.
- **Analytics and performance cookies:** We use these cookies to monitor website performance and understand user behaviour. This helps us to improve the website's functionality and user experience. All data collected by these cookies is anonymised and used solely for internal purposes.
- **Social media integration:** While browsing our site, no social media cookies are automatically set. However, if you interact with embedded content, such as YouTube videos or social media buttons, cookies from those platforms may be set on your device. We have no control over these cookies and their respective policies.

Managing your cookie preferences:

You have the right to control the cookies stored on your device. Here's how you can manage your preferences:

- **Changing cookie settings:** You can update or withdraw your consent at any time by visiting the Cookie Declaration on our website. Alternatively, most browsers allow you to block or delete cookies through their settings.
- **Removing cookies:** You can clear existing cookies stored on your device by clearing your browser history. This will remove all cookies, but it may also remove saved preferences and login information from other sites.
- **Blocking cookies:** By blocking cookies in your browser settings, you may affect the performance and usability of our website, as some features rely on cookies to function properly. You might need to manually adjust settings each time you visit the site if cookies are blocked.

Below are instructions for managing cookies in some common browsers:

- **Google chrome:** Go to *Settings > Privacy and Security > Clear Browsing Data* and select "Cookies and other site data".
- **Mozilla firefox:** Go to *Options > Privacy & Security > Cookies and Site Data* and click "Clear Data".
- **Safari:** Go to *Preferences > Privacy > Manage Website Data*, then click "Remove All" to delete all cookies.

Do Not Track (DNT) option:

Some browsers offer a "Do Not Track" (DNT) feature, which signals to websites that you do not wish to be tracked. If you enable DNT in your browser, our website will respect this preference and not collect tracking data. You can enable this option in your browser's privacy settings.

Third-party cookies:

Some cookies are placed by third-party services integrated into our website, such as analytics platforms or social media providers. These third parties have their own privacy and cookie policies, over which we have no control. For example:

- **Vimeo:** We use Vimeo to embed videos on our website. Vimeo may place cookies on your device to track video viewership and analytics. You can review Vimeo's cookie policies on their website.
- **YouTube:** Embedded YouTube videos on our site are displayed using privacy-enhanced mode, meaning no cookies are set unless you interact with the video. YouTube's cookies are subject to Google's privacy policies.

Opting in and out:

When you first visit our website, you will be presented with a choice to accept or decline cookies. You can choose to accept all cookies for an optimal experience or decline non-essential cookies. If you neither accept nor decline, the cookie banner will continue to appear until a choice is made.

If you change your mind after accepting cookies, you can opt out at any time by clearing cookies from your browser or revisiting our website's Cookie Declaration.
